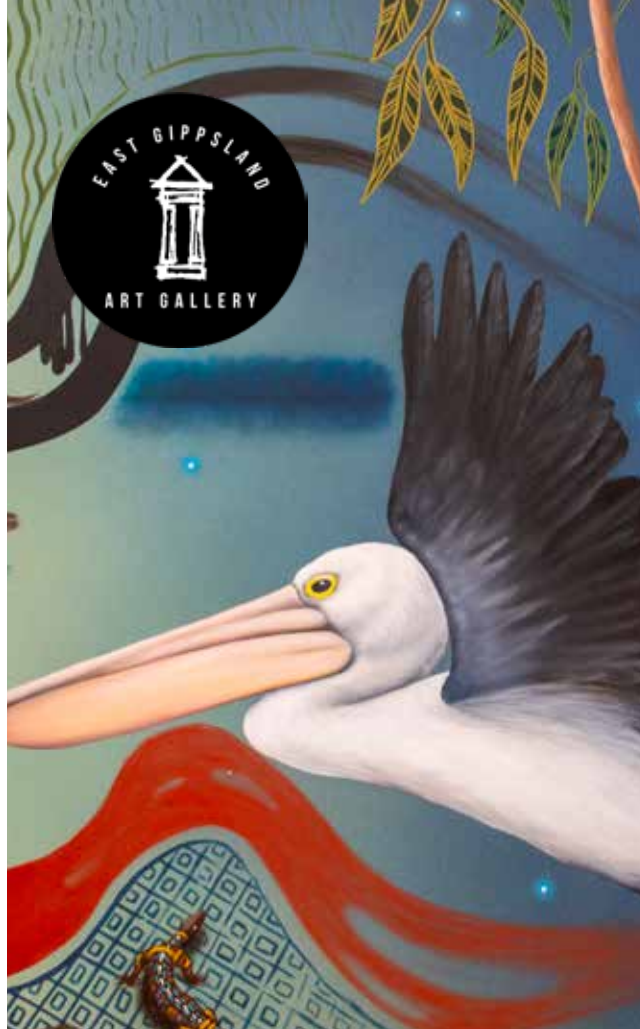

Ross Wilson is one of Australia’s most awarded, respected, and well-known artists! From the legendary band Daddy Cool whose number one

anthem “Eagle Rock” and debut album “Daddy Who?” smashed all previous sales records in Australia an astounding 50 years ago in 1971, to the 1977 formation of Mondo Rock, delivering 80’s hits ‘Cool World’, ‘State of The Heart’, ‘Chemistry’, ‘No Time’, and ‘Come Said The Boy’ and into the 21st century as a solo performer, Wilson has never been out of the limelight.

His latest release in 2023 “She’s Stuck On Facebook All The Time” is a modern-day tragicomedy in the blues genre. Twice inducted into the ARIA Hall of Fame, Wilson’s live performances are legendary.

He excels in his use of the every day mundane details of life to spark recognition and understanding in his audience before often delivering quite profound messages. Issues are tackled with a raw honesty in these songs

but, often, the confronting impact of the serious subject matter is softened by Smith’s deft employment of playful and appealing humour.

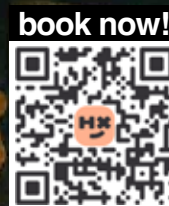
