LOCAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHAT TO DO DURING A LOCAL INCIDENT: FIRE, FLOOD, STORM, ETC

GET READY NOW



Develop a personal incident plan



Make sure vehicle has fuel



Pack an emergency kit



Prepare your house

WHAT TO TAKE



Protective clothing including hat, long sleeve top and pants and sturdy footwear



Food and water



Phone and charger, radio



Prescriptions, medication and toiletries



Torch and batteries



Important documents, photos, insurance, USB sticks, etc



Pet needs

WHEN TO LEAVE



When you hear an incident will impact your area



Close windows, doors, curtains, turn off gas and appliances



When advised by CFA, SES, DEECA, Vic Police, Radio



Notify family / friends when you leave

LEAVE EARLY



DO NOT rely on electricity to fight fires



DO NOT drive in smoke or flood water

WHAT TO EXPECT IN AN EMERGENCY



Limited visibility



Limited access



Crowded at Assembly Area



Loss of power and phone communication

DESIGNATED ASSEMBLY AREA

The initial assembly area for Furnell Landing is the car park near the public toilets

FIRE:

In the event of the closure of Tamboon Road the safest place is the ocean beach or Tamboon South. You will need a boat to get there

FLOOD:

In the event of a flood the safest place is the car park or higher ground
