#### Office of the CEO

## 1.1 Presentation from Department of Transport and Planning

Councillors received a presentation from the Department of Transport and Planning that provided an overview of their regional operations, including its integrated approach to transport and land use planning, key priorities for Gippsland, ongoing and future infrastructure projects, maintenance strategies.

#### 1.2 Project Management Review

Councillors were briefed on the Project Management Review and the work currently in progress to refresh and enhance Council's revised Project Management Framework (PMF). Based on these discussions, revised Guiding Principles will be presented to Council for formal consideration in November.

#### 1.3 Strategic Advocacy Information Session

Councillors received a presentation on Strategic Advocacy and an independent assessment of the state of play in the lead up to the State Elections.

The overview covered:

- what opportunities may arise ahead of the 2026 state election;
- · how to create leverage for advocacy efforts; and
- how advocacy approaches change when dealing with government, the opposition and members of parliament.

Councillors discussed key challenges and key opportunities facing the region.
