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Important Notes about Objections to Permit Applications

1. **Using This Form:** This form helps you object to a planning permit application under the Planning and Environment Act 1987. You don't have to use this form; you can also object by letter or email. Just include your contact info and the required response to why you object and how you would be affected. If you don't give written consent, your phone number and email won't be shared with others.
2. **Understand the Proposal:** Before objecting, make sure you understand the proposal. You can view full details at your nearest Service Centre or on the Council's website under the [Advertised Planning Permit Application](#) Section.
3. **What to Include in Your Objection:** Your objection should explain:
 - Why you object to the application, and
 - How you would be affected if a permit is granted.
4. **Commercial Benefit:** Council may reject objections made for commercial gain. This is based on the Planning and Environment Act 1987 and legal precedent.
5. **Inspecting Objections:** Anyone can inspect an objection during Council office hours. The applicant and any objector can also request a digital copy of an objection, provided a declaration is made according to the Privacy Statement.
6. **Impacts at any address:** If your objection relates to impacts on property other than your home or mailing address (like public land, a workplace, or recreational area), provide those details in the 'Objector address impacted by the proposal' field.
7. **Council Consideration:** Council must consider all objections before making a decision. They won't decide before the latest date listed on Form 2 (or Form 3 for an amended permit), as mailed to neighbours, displayed on-site, or published in a local newspaper.
8. **Notification of Decision:** If you object before the decision is made, Council will notify you of its decision via a Notice of Decision to Grant (or Amend) a Planning Permit.
9. **Review Rights:** The Notice of Decision will explain your rights to review the decision at VCAT, the timeframe for applying for a review, and how to contact VCAT.
10. **Responding to an Appeal:** If Council refuses or fails to decide and the applicant seeks a review, objectors will be contacted through the VCAT process and can join as Respondents.
11. **Privacy:** If you don't consent, your phone number and email will be redacted before being shared with others. All contact info will be redacted before being published online. Council will use your email and phone number to contact you about your objection and provide updates on meetings and decisions.
12. **Other Submissions:** Don't use this form for submissions about planning scheme changes, development plans, or other planning/building matters. Council will advertise the correct way to make submissions for these, including contact details for more information.
