

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURES

DURING AN EMERGENCY, THE AIR HORN WILL SOUND

- 1. Assist persons in immediate danger ONLY IF SAFE TO DO SO
- 2. Raise the alarm Alert park staff and notify emergency services CALL 000
- 3. Secure your valuables and close all windows, doors and hatches.
- 4. Turn off the power and gas to your site.
- 5. Gather your family. Collect any blankets, towels and drinking water.
- 6. Proceed to the designated assembly area.
- 7. Remain in the assembly area until told it is safe to leave.


DO NOT TRY TO MOVE YOUR CAR OR CARAVAN UNLESS **INSTRUCTED TO DO SO**


This may hinder emergency services.

SETTING UP YOUR SITE

It is important that your site is set up in accordance with Country Fire Authority regulations. These are put in place to ensure all sites are accessible to emergency services in the case of a fire.

- IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER:
- 2000 mm between structure walls
- 1200 mm unobstructed at all times e.g. guide ropes
